Dear Parent/Carers

As December is rapidly approaching, we thought that you would like to know how we at Engaines would be celebrating this year.

Due to Covid-19 restrictions, we, as all schools, have had to rethink a lot of our Christmas traditions. We are unable to put on performances in the same way this year. As a result we will be sharing on Google classrooms, or Tapestry in Early Years and Nursery, a short class performance from each class, so please ensure that you all know how to logon to the appropriate platform.

The week beginning the 14<sup>th</sup> of December, will begin our Christmas celebrations. The classrooms will be decorated and the children will be completing Christmas crafts, having Christmas parties, and watching a virtual pantomime, Jack and the Beanstalk, purchased by the PTA. In addition, we will be delivering Christmas themed numeracy and literacy.
